The Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP) is mandated by the Political Parties Act (PPA), 2011, Sec 34 to carry out the following:

- a) Register, regulate, monitor, investigate and supervise political parties to ensure compliance with this Act;
- b) Administer the Fund;
- c) Ensure publication of audited annual accounts of political parties;
- d) Verify and make publicly available the list of all members of political parties;
- e) Maintain a register of political parties and the symbols of the political parties;
- f) Ensure and verify that no person is a member of more than one political party and notify the Commission on its findings; and
- g) Investigate complaints received under this Act;

RE: COMPLIANCE STATUS OF FUND FILE FOR PARTY OF DEMOCRATIC UNION

The Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP) is mandated under Sec.34 of the Political Parties Act (PPA), 2011 to: -Register, regulate, monitor, investigate, and supervise political parties to ensure compliance with the Act.

In line with Section 29 and 31 a political party shall, within ninety days of the end of its financial year, publish the sources of its funds stating the amount of money received from the Fund; and that received from its members income and expenditure of the political party; assets and liabilities of the political party and submit to the Auditor-General for audit.

According to records held at ORPP, your party has complied with the above provisions of the Act.
